Final Pieces of the World's First Dueling Water Coaster Set for Installation as Wet 'n' Wild Water Park Nears Completion

WHAT: Wet 'n' Wild Phoenix (www.phoenixwetnwild.com), a new \$30 million water park located in North Phoenix near I-17, on Pinnacle Peak Road, is installing the final pieces of **Maximum Velocity** – the world's first, gravity-defying, dueling Master Blaster water coaster.

Considered the park's "hero ride," Maximum Velocity will be the **only slide in the world** that features the Master Blaster technology and allows guests to race side-by-side in two tandem tubes. It is also the final slide to be installed in the eagerly awaited park, which opens this June.

VISUALS:**

- Final sections of **Maximum Velocity** will be hoisted through the air and into place, providing future riders with a sneak peek at the heart-pumping slide before it opens this summer.
- Opportunities to see other completed slide structures at the park, including:
 - **Tornado**, which catapults riders into a 45-foot-tall funnel and drops them into a swirling splashdown pool
 - **Desert Racers**, which takes riders head first on a racing mat through an enclosed tube, and then loops them into a six-lane downhill speedway
 - **Raging River**, which takes up to six people down 600 feet of the Raging River's canyon walls, around sharp turns and over steep drops
- Spokespeople will be on hand to conduct interviews and provide behind-the-scenes tours of Arizona's largest water park.
